Overview

It is possible to trigger CV import, invoke Entities, Workflows or Business Objects in Adapt from the external web applications by accessing and executing the Adapt JavaScript Services.

Access to the Adapt functions is provided through the Adapt JavaScript object, that must be loaded first within the external webpage:

```
<script
    type="text/javascript"
    src="http://<AdaptServerIP:port>/WebApp/external/Adapt.js">
</script>
```

Once a loaded, Adapt object provides JavaScript Services (Modules) to trigger Adapt functions, the **loadModule** service must be set to make available Modules and core utilities such as Logging mechanism.

loadModule service

loadModule(moduleName, onloadFunction) function loads and enables the specified Module of the Adapt core object. When the module is loaded, the given function is executed.

Note Adapt core object must be loaded first to enable loading of its Module.

For more information on how to load Adapt core object, refer to the <u>Overview</u> section of this document.

Syntax

Adapt.loadModule(Adapt.ModuleNames.[ModuleName],[onloadFunctionName](){})

Parameters

ModuleName

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: The name of the Module to load.

Note The full list of all the available Modules can be found in the Overview section of this

document

<u>onloadFunction</u>

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: The function to run once the module has finished loading.

Example

Load the **UI** Module and execute the specified function once the **UI** Module has been loaded. The function returns alert saying 'UI Module is loaded':

UI Module

UI Module holds functions under the Adapt object which are used to import CV, invoke Entity, Workflow or Business Object in the Adapt Standard User Runtime.

UI Module Functions are built on top of the http-formatted External Request strings and possess the same capabilities in triggering actions in the Adapt Standard User Runtime.

openEntity(callData) function opens the specified Entity in the Standard User Runtime.

Syntax

     "id" :[EntityID],
"roleId" :[RoleID],
     "segmentId" :[SegmentID],

     "profileId" :[ProfileID],
```

callData

A set of parameters that are passed in the form of a JSONObject:

<u>id</u>

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: ID of the Entity to open

<u>roleID</u>

Usage: Optional

Definition: ID of the Role to open the Entity as. Useful when Entity possesses several Roles.

Note

If the target Entity possesses several Roles and roleID parameter is not specified in the request string, the Entity View opens using the default Role.

segmentId

Usage: Optional

Definition: ID of the Segment to open

domainId

Usage: Conditional (must be specified if **profileId** parameter is used)

Definition: ID of the Domain the target Entity belongs to

Note

If domainId is not specified, the Domain the user is currently logged into will be considered.

If domainId is specified but differs from the ID of the Domain that the user is currently logged into, the request will be refused and message box asking to log off the Adapt in order to log in back to the correct Domain appears in the Standard User Runtime. In this case **openEntity** function must be triggered one more time.

In case user is not logged in at the moment, the appropriate Domain needs to be

Usage: Conditional (must be specified if **domainId** parameter is used) Definition: ID of the Domain Profile the target Entity belongs to

Note

If **profileId** is not specified, the Domain Profile the user is currently logged into will be considered.

If **profileId** is specified but differs from the ID of the Domain Profile that the user is currently logged into, the request will be refused and message box asking to log off the Adapt in order to log in back to the correct Domain Profile appears in the Standard User Runtime. In this case **openEntity** function must be triggered one more time.

In case user is not logged in at the moment, the appropriate Domain Profile needs to be manually selected on the Adapt Login page.

openWorkflow(callData)

openWorkflow(callData) function opens the specified Workflow View in the Standard User Runtime.

Syntax

callData

A set of parameters that are passed in the form of a JSONObject:

<u>id</u>

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: ID of the Workflow View to open

callerView

Usage: Optional

Definition: ID of the Entity to open first (i.e. one the Workflow will be launched from) prefixed with **E**. Useful in case Workflow picks up data from the Entity it was called from.

domainId

Usage: Conditional (must be specified if **profileId** is used)

Definition: ID of the Domain the target Workflow View belongs to

Note

If **domainId** is not specified, the Domain the user is currently logged into will be considered.

If **domainId** is specified but differs from ID of the Domain the user is currently logged into, the request will be refused, and message box asking to log off the Adapt in order to log in back to the correct Domain will appear in the Standard User Runtime. In this case **openWorkflow** function must be triggered one more time.

In case user is not logged in at the moment, the appropriate Domain will need to be manually selected on the Adapt Login page.

Definition: ID of the Domain Profile the target Workflow View belongs to

Note

If **profileId** is not specified, the Domain Profile the user is currently logged into will be considered.

If **profileId** is specified but differs from ID of the Domain Profile the user is currently logged into, the request will be refused, and message box asking to log off the Adapt in order to log in back to the correct Domain Profile will appear in the Standard User Runtime. In this case **openWorkflow** function must be triggered one more time.

workflowParam

Usage: Optional

Definition: Names of Workflow Controls with values to pre-populate a Workflow View in the form of URLencoded JSON Object.

Note

Workflow Controls are pre-populated with values in the same way as the values are set using a Business Object.

Note

Only Control names need to be specified as the full Control path is obtained based on the ID of the Workflow View to open.

Syntax of passing the parameters depends on the type of Controls to be pre-populated:

Reference Text Box Control:

```

Alpha Text Box Control:

```

Format of the "NumericValue" inserted into a Numeric Text Box Control on a Workflow View may be different from the format specified in the function. This is caused by applying the automatic formatting according to the Numeric parsing rules.

runBO(callData) function invokes the specified Business Object.

Syntax

callData

A set of parameters that are passed in the form of a JSONObject:

<u>id</u>

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: ID of the Business Object to execute

callerView

Usage: Optional

Definition: ID of the Entity to open first (prefixed with **E**). Useful in case Business Object picks up Entity related data.

domainId

Usage: Conditional (must be specified if **profileId** is used)

Definition: ID of the Domain the target Business Object belongs to.

<u>Note</u>

If **domainId** is not specified, the Domain the user is currently logged into will be considered.

If **domainId** is specified but differs from ID of the Domain the user is currently logged into, the request will be refused, and message box asking to log off the Adapt in order to log in back to the correct Domain will appear in the Standard User Runtime. In this case **runBO** function must be triggered one more time.

In case user is not logged in at the moment, the appropriate Domain will need to be manually selected on the Adapt Login page.

callData

A set of parameters that are passed in the form of a JSONObject:

cvURL

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: **Encoded path** to the local file in the **file:///** or **file://** format, or **encoded URL** to the file stored on the external website in the **http://** format from which a CV can be downloaded.

linkedServer

Usage: Conditional (must be used if **cvURL** contains path to the file stored on the external website in

the **http://** format)

Definition: Name of the linked server.

Note

When **linkedServer** parameter is used, the file's URL will be passed to the specified linked server first in order to verify that file to be downloaded is not harmful. The ADAPT_AUTH and ADAPT_SSN parameters get automatically appended to the download URL, so that the linked server can authenticate the received request.

After the downloaded file passes verification, linked server transfers it to the application server for further processing by Adapt CV Import module.

domainId

Usage: Conditional (must be specified if **profileId** is used) Definition: ID of the Domain the CV will be imported to.

A set of parameters that are passed in the form of a JSONObject:

cvURLs

Usage: Mandatory

Definition: Array of Encoded paths to the local files in the file:/// or file:// format, or encoded URLs to the files stored on the external websites in the http:// format from which CVs can be downloaded.

linkedServer

Usage: Conditional (must be used if cvURLs contains path to the files stored on the external websites in the **http://** format)

Definition: Name of the linked server.

Note

When linkedServer parameter is used, the files URLs will be passed to the specified linked server first in order to verify that files to be downloaded are not harmful. The ADAPT AUTH and ADAPT SSN parameters get automatically appended to the download URL, so that the linked server can authenticate the received request.

After the downloaded files pass verification, linked server transfers them to the application server for further processing by Adapt CV Import module.

Logging

There is an ability to store log entries in the named logger objects. Adapt modules have their own loggers registered in here and you can add your own. Loggers can be enabled/disabled and the log entries can be viewed in a popup window.

Functions

Functions	Description
getNewLogger(name)	Creates and returns a new instance of Simple Logger object
enableLogger(name)	Enables the Logger object to accept the new log entries
disableLogger(name)	Disables the Logger object to accept the new log entries
viewLogger(name)	Opens a popup window listing the log entries of the specified Logger object

viewLogger(name) function opens a popup window listing the log entries of the specified Logger object.

Syntax












Workflow that opens with pre-populated fields:


